General Information

Are airfare discounts available?

Yes, AirCanada has provided external delegates with a discount code that can be used to receive a discount on your airfare, exclusively for the purpose of the conference, please email uofanew@ualberta.ca to receive your code. The flights must fly into and out of Calgary, AB, as this is where we will be picking you up via chartered bus.

Reminder, when booking flights, please leave a few hours before and after in case of delays. NEW will not be responsible for transportation if your flight is delayed.

What is the weather like in Lake Louise?

Cold! The temperature in the mountains usually ranges from 0 to -15 degrees Celsius, so bring warm attire!

How many bags can I bring on the bus?

You may bring one large bag or suitcase, which will be stored under the bus, as well as one small carry-on and one suit/dress bag to have with you in the passenger cabin.

suit, pantsuit, or dress. (Formal)




Is it mandatory to attend all scheduled keynote and breakout presentations?




Maps




Queen of the Night Hospitality Suite FRIDAY MARCH 15TH, 2024
